

MCMA PEER RECOGNITION AWARDS SUBMISSION FORM

The Education Committee wants to engage the MCMA Membership in meaningful ways to promote and recognize the diverse range of work taking place in the Provincial Offences Courts across the province.

Scope

The MCMA Peer Recognition Awards are intended to recognize quality work from members who set an example while including others; to celebrate the efforts of members who value and respect the well-being of other people in achieving large scale goals; and to value those who exhibit openness to new ideas and partnerships, and who encourage involvement of the membership.

Eligibility

All members of the MCMA in good standing are eligible to participate in this program. A member cannot win the same award two years in a row.

Nominations

Any association member may nominate an individual in any or all of the categories. A separate nomination form must be submitted for each category. Every Regional Lead and Committee Chair/Co-Chair is encouraged to promote submissions from their regions or committees in one or more of the three categories, or by submitting nominations themselves. Individuals do not have to nominate someone from their own region or committee. Submissions will include a description of how the nominee shows excellence in the category in which they were nominated through one or more of the criteria listed. Each submission will be posted to the MCMA website. Once posted, all members can review the submissions at <https://mcmaontario.ca>.

Nominations will be submitted by email to the Chair, Education Committee. Deadline for submissions is February 21st of each year. Voting will take place between March 10th and March 28th through a Survey. Voting will be confidential and anonymous.

The awards jury shall consist of three members of the Education Committee not nominated for an award. In the case there are not three available Education Committee members to form the awards jury, additional members shall be solicited from the Board members who are not nominated for an award, by the Committee Chair.

Successful Candidates

Candidates with the most votes will be deemed the winner. There will be one winner in each category. In case of a tie, the winner shall be determined by the designated awards jury based on the merits of the submission meeting the established criteria for the category. The winners will be announced at the MCMA Annual Conference.
