- Option 3: Trial option – I intend to appear in court to plead not guilty



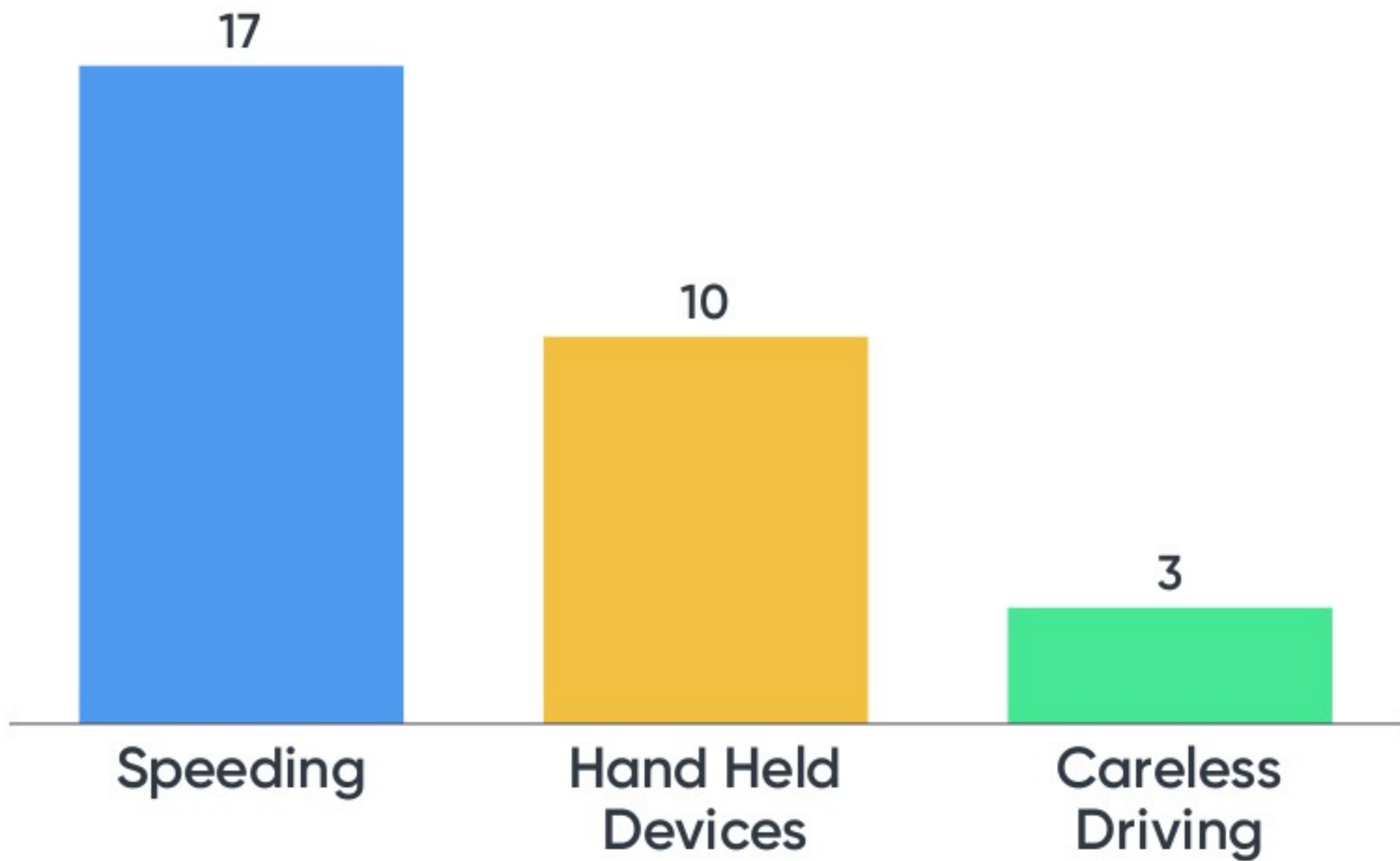
Charge Screening
